Productivity Places Program (PPP) is the Australian Government "Skilling Australia" plan for the future.

What is the cost involved?

IT'S FREE, if you are looking for work. The Australian Government will fully fund your training under this program.

Who is eligible?

You are eligible if you are:

- currently looking for work
- an Australian citizen or permanent resident over the age of 15.

How do you apply for free training?

There are two ways:

1. Apply through your Job Network member.
2. If you are not registered with an employment service provider, you need to apply directly to Australian College QED.

What courses are currently funded?

1. Certificate II in Retail Operations WRR20102 Normal Fee \$1295—FREE

2. Certificate II in Tourism (Operations) THT20502 Normal Fee \$1295—FREE

3. Certificate III in Children's Services CHC30402 Normal Fee \$1699—FREE

4. Certificate III in Financial Services (Accounts Clerical) FNS30304 Normal Fee \$1395—FREE

5. Certificate III in Tourism (International Retail Travel Sales) THT30302 Normal Fee \$1899—FREE

- evidence of registration with an employment service provider; or
- evidence of receipt of pension or benefits; or
- Statutory Declaration plus evidence of Australian citizenship or permanent residency
